20 July 2016, Budapest, Hungary

Objectives

The Danube-INCO.NET 4th Clustering Workshop aims at stimulating the establishment of macro-regional and transnational partnerships among stakeholders active in the field of bio-based economy. Thus, a matchmaking will be promoted between ideas - showcased in the context of an elevator pitch - and funding opportunities - with a focus on Horizon 2020 Work Programme 2016-2017 and particularly on the calls managed by the Bio-based Industries Joint Undertaking.

Details

In line with the objectives of the Danube-INCO.NET project, as well as with those of WP3 “Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy in a Bio-based Economy”, the Danube-INCO.NET 4th Clustering Workshop will contribute to the development of bio-based economy in the Danube Region. The event is linked to the Conference “Supporting the development of bio-based economy partnerships in the Danube Region through a triple-helix approach”, of which it is a natural follow-up. Indeed, by drawing on the best practices highlighted in the context of the Triple-Helix Conference, the 4th Clustering Workshop will promote concrete cooperative actions among selected stakeholders from academia, government and businesses (a maximum of 30-35 participants may be envisaged). An elevator pitch will allow for highlighting possible creative ideas from young researchers and innovators, while funding opportunities will be presented in order to help turn ideas into actions.
